

MD Theses

The FBI offers the opportunity for medical students to obtain their MD theses. For this purpose, we are looking for medical students with a strong interest in Neurology and Neuroscience.

Time duration: To do a MD thesis at the FBI part-time will take at least one year. If you do the MD thesis full-time, it will take at least half a year.

Volume of work: Usually, a MD thesis consists of performing an experiment, which has been designed and planned before. Your job would be the recruitment of healthy subjects and patients, performing the imaging experiments and analyzing the data with SPM or another software. It might be possible that you also have to program an experiment.

Previous knowledge: No specific previous knowledge is needed. However, it is useful to have good computer skills and a broad knowledge of neuroanatomy.
