

Professor Reinhard was appointed chair and head of the Eye Center Freiburg in 2003. Since then he implemented innovative concepts in diagnostics, treatment and science with his co-workers. He led the Eye Center Freiburg into the top group of German eye hospitals. Milestones were the implementation of a quality check system, development of the LIONS Cornea Bank Baden-Württemberg, development of the Augennetz Südbaden, implementation of an emergency unit for 6 counties/cities, development of the eye bus concept and the development of a prevention unit. In the Eye Center Freiburg, habilitations have been achieved in 28 coworkers since 2003. 63 colleagues have finished residency since 2003. Professor Reinhard has held many executive functions in national and international boards. He has held different functions in the German Ophthalmological Society (DOG), the oldest ophthalmological society in the world, e.g. as president and secretary general, and realized a number of significant changes and improvements. Present and future topics and ideas were addressed in that time very successfully and effectively.
