This project aims to establish a German-Asian research network and to develop integrative, multimodal treatment methods for psychosocial diseases. Besides enriching psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy, this project may also contribute to the improvement of public health systems in countries where rapid cultural and social transformations are taking place.

This program supports cross cultural research in the field of psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy, the education of future faculty in each institute, and the development of a research structure/network in Vietnam and China.

The German team offers training courses and workshops for medical doctors and psychologists in Hanoi, Hue and Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam, and Shanghai and Peking in China.
